These Fees & Charges are subject to Newquay Cornwall Airport's Conditions of Use and replace all previous editions of the Fees & Charges.

Subject to any variations agreed in writing, these Fees & Charges apply to all persons using goods and services provided for and on behalf of Newquay Cornwall Airport.

1. Passenger Charges

Passenger Charges are applicable to all Departing Passengers.

Passenger Load Supplement

£12.00 per Departing Passenger

Airport Safety and Security Levy

£3.00 per Departing Passenger

Hold Baggage Screening (HBS)

£0.20 per Departing Passenger

This charge is calculated to recover the airport's labour costs and the capital cost of providing HBS equipment.

Passengers with Reduced Mobility (PRM)

£0.20 per arriving or departing passenger.

Diversions

Passenger Charges for air transport movements diverted to Newquay Cornwall Airport will apply to arriving passengers with the exception of HBS.

2. Runway Charges

Runway Charges are levied on all departures and based on the Maximum Take-Off Weight of departing aircraft.

Landing Fees

Aircraft under 2.5 tonnes

Under 1 tonne £24.00

1 to 1.5 tonnes £35.00

1.5 to 2.0 tonnes £46.00

2 tonnes to 2.5 tonnes £54.00

Over 2.5 tonnes £19.00 per tonne or part

Discounts for multiple landings may be available.

Positioning Flights

50% of landing fee

Aircraft Training

£300.00 per three hour block or part

Discounts for multiple block bookings are available.

Out of Hours Operation

A surcharge based on RFFS category, will apply per turnaround during the Night Period (2200-0630 local time), in addition to the charges above.

Category 1-2 £300 per hour or part thereof

Category 3-4 £400 per hour or part thereof

Category 5 £450 per hour or part thereof

Category 6 £550 per hour or part thereof

Category 7 £650 per hour or part thereof

Late Opening – Passenger Terminal

A surcharge based on RFFS category, will apply for late opening of the Passenger Terminal during the Night Period (2230-0500 local time), in addition to the charges above.

Category 1-6 £100 per hour or part thereof

Category 7 £130 per hour or part thereof

Diversions

Runway Charges for air transport movements diverted to Newquay Cornwall Airport will apply on landing.

Cancelled Departure Charges

For cancellations within 90 minutes of scheduled departure time a charge equivalent to 50% of the Passenger load supplement, Security levy and Wheelchair levy will apply

3. Aircraft Parking

Parking Fees

There is no charge for the first 90 minutes of parking. Thereafter for each period of 24 hours or part thereof the following charges apply:

0-3 tonnes	£2.00 per tonne or part thereof
Over 3 tonnes	£4.00 per tonne or part thereof
>100 tonnes	£5.00 per tonne or part thereof

Hangarage Fees (ad-hoc)

Up to 6 tonnes £100 per day or part thereof
Over 6 tonnes £250 per day or part thereof
Reduced rates may be available for very light weight aircraft

Compass Calibration/Swing (Class 1)

Up to 3 tonnes £50 per use
Over 3 tonnes £150 per use

Fire Tender

The charge for the attendance of a fire tender and crew to cover engine starting or refuelling is £165.00 per hour.

Stand Cleaning

The charge for cleaning soiled aircrafts stands (e.g. through fuel spillage, dumped hydraulic fluid, split sewage etc) is based on the labour time and materials used. The minimum charge is £200.00.
